Key Learning Points

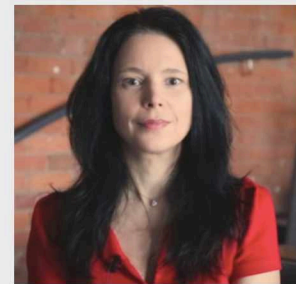
